ALL VEHICLES WILL BE SEARCHED -- ALL BAGS WILL BE SEARCHED UPON ENTERING FESTIVAL GROUNDS
FOR YOUR FUN AND SAFETY, PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING:

Allowed in Campgrounds but NOT in Concert/Festival Grounds:

- Glass
- Coolers
- Aerosol cans
- Outside beverages and food for personal consumption
- Pets - please keep leashed, within your campsite, and dispose of all waste
- Wagons
- Tents and canopies that fit within campsite
- Non-metallic flagpoles (fiberglass, PVC, vinyl) with a max height of 15 ft
- Gas and charcoal grills for cooking
- Small properly contained cooking fires only

Allowed in Campgrounds and Concert/Festival Grounds:

- Wheelchairs, medical scooters
- Push strollers for children
- Aerosol sunscreen
- Ice in permitted bag/soft cooler (12-pack or smaller)

Prohibitions will be STRICTLY enforced!

Festival reserves the right to deny entry or remove from the Festival or Campgrounds anyone in violation of these policies or for conduct deemed disorderly.

Other items may be refused after being deemed inappropriate or unsafe, including unreasonable amounts of alcohol or food, at the discretion of Festival Producers.

Any items left unattended near the entrances will be thrown away.

Please use common sense when planning the amount of alcohol to bring and consume. You, and everyone around you, will enjoy the Festival much more if you consume alcohol responsibly!

- Motorcycles in the infield
- Bicycles, trikes
- Drones, remote-controlled aircraft, cars or toys
- Metal flagpoles
- Staking on asphalt surfaces
- Unauthorized vending or solicitation, including food and alcohol
- Unauthorized flyers, sampling, give-aways, etc.
- Wrapped or heavily branded vehicles
- Weapons of any kind
- Drugs and drug paraphernalia
- Fireworks and explosives
- Golf carts or other personal transport devices (e.g. skateboards, Segways, go-peds, hoverboards, etc.) except pre-approved for patrons with mobility limitations
- Powered carts, ATVs, three-wheeled vehicles, scooters, lift trucks, tractor trailers, box trucks or buses
- Fences (bike rack, plastic, etc.)
- Construction of any type of free-standing scaffolding or platforms
- Cruising or excessive and unnecessary driving
- Loud music
- Dumping of waste or waste water on the ground
- Large amounts of alcohol
